

## General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) – Complying with the new law.

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In May 2018 our current data protection laws will be completely replaced by new laws under the General Data Protection Regulation. This one-day workshop will help you understand the changes introduced by the GDPR and focus on the measures your organisation will need to implement to ensure that it is compliant.
